

Accessing ERM for Applicants

Chrome, Firefox, and Safari browsers all work well with ERM.

Chrome is the preferred browser to use for ERM as it has additional settings that complement the full functionality of ERM as well as the ability to adjust the font size.

For QUT users, you can access ERM from either:
